# Operation Encompass

We would like to make you aware that Cardinal Wiseman Catholic School has been given the opportunity to take part in a project that will run jointly between schools and the West Midlands Police.

Operation Encompass reports to school when a child or young person has been exposed to, or involved in, any domestic incident.

Operation Encompass will ensure that a member of the school staff, known as a Key Adult, is trained to allow them to liaise with the police. The Key Adult will use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to ensure that the school is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families, who have been involved in, or exposed to, a domestic abuse incident.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
