



As we progress through the Liturgical year the month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary. The history of the Rosary as a prayer can be traced back to 1206 when Mary appeared to St Dominic. Mary praised Dominic for his valiant fight against heresy and gave St Dominic the Rosary as a mighty weapon and explained its uses and efficacy and told him to preach it to others. Since then Catholic families have prayed the Rosary together and found that it is a powerful practice that speaks to the core of our faith. Pope Benedict XVI in an address at the Basilica of St Mary Major said:



“Today, together we confirm that the Holy Rosary is not a pious practice banished to the past, like prayers of other times thought of with nostalgia. Instead, the Rosary is experiencing a new Springtime. Without a doubt, this is one of the most eloquent signs of love that the young generation nourish for Jesus and his Mother, Mary.”

We ask you to join in us this month in reciting the Rosary and if your children would like to find out more about this prayer they will have an opportunity to be part of the after school liturgy and prayer group run by Mr Kapoor on Tuesday's after school.



Zero Tolerance on Abuse

In July last academic year, we wrote to all parents and stakeholders about our new approach to behaviour and the implementation of the 100% compliance rule. This has been extremely successful in improving the standards of behaviour across the school and allowing our pupils and staff to focus on teaching and learning.



We are supported by all of the unions across the country such as the NASUWT (National Association of Schoolmasters Union of Women Teachers) and the NAHT (National Association of Headteachers) in ensuring that no member of staff should be abused verbally or physically in their place of work.
