## LEADERSHIP UPDATE

**“However, when the Spirit of truth comes he will lead you to the complete truth, since he will not be speaking of his own accord, but will say only what he has been told; and he will reveal to you the things to come.” Gospel, *John 16:12-15***

This Sunday’s reading is taken from the Gospel of St John and speaks about the revelations of the Holy Spirit and the way we will be lead through acknowledging the truth. It is perhaps poignant that we read about the Holy Spirit at the time that our students come to the end of their examinations, as we ask that the Holy Spirit will guide them as they begin the next stage of their journey through life and consider the education pathways they will take at post 16.
