Acceptable Uniform from September 2019

BOYS MUST WEAR

- Blazer navy with school badge.
- Black trousers (no jeans or chinos see illustration overleaf).
- White school shirt Years 7, 8 and 9; blue school shirt Years 10 and 11 (no fashion or sports) collar buttoned, shirt tucked into trousers.
- School tie House colours.
- Navy, black or dark grey socks.
- Black lace up or slip on shoes/ankle/shoe boots. (no logos, heavy boots, training shoes, canvas pumps/plimsolls or Velcro see illustration).
- No baseball caps to be worn in school.
- Blazers should be worn to and from school.

GIRLS MUST WEAR

- Blazer navy with school badge.
- Black knee length skirt (no mini, split, wrap around, divided or tight skirts, no Lycra skirts) black trousers of acceptable width or style (no jeans, cords or leggings/jeggings, no skinny trousers see illustration).
- White school shirt Years 7, 8 and 9; blue school shirt Years 10 and 11 (no fashion or sports) — collar buttoned, shirt tucked in.
- School tie House colours.
- Plain black tights (40 denier) or plain black/white ankle socks. No knee high socks allowed.
- Plain black shoes heels no higher than 1.5"/4cms. (No fashion shoes/boots, training shoes, canvas pumps/plimsolls, stiletto heels, sandals, platform shoes or sling back shoes).
- Blazers should be worn to and from school.



BOYS/GIRLS MAY WEAR

- Official school jumper navy blue with school logo.
- A plain dark coloured coat without emblems or badges.
- Nb No hoodies.

JEWELLERY— Some jewellery is allowed:

- Students may wear one pair small stud earrings (in ear lobes only no body or facial piercings permitted).
- One chain must be worn under school shirt.
- One flat ring permitted.
- Watch permitted.
- Wearing of religious bracelets is permitted.
- The wearing of head scarves for religious reasons is permitted. However, head scarves
 must be plain black or navy, although in hot weather white or cream plain scarves will be
 permitted.
- Students are not permitted to cover their faces.
- Students are not allowed to have their coat hoods up at any time in the school buildings.

MAKE-UP/TATTOOS —

- No make-up or nail varnish to be worn.
- No acrylic nails.
- No false eyelashes.
- No tattoos.

HAIR — In keeping with our traditional uniform, we promote traditional hair styles. Exceptions: non-traditional styles will be at the Principal's discretion.

- If students dye their hair, only natural colours should be used.
- Boys must not come to school with lines or patterns shaved into their hair (or eye brows).

SHOES FOR GIRLS

Plain black shoes — heels no higher than 1.5"/4cms. (No fashion shoes/boots, training shoes, canvas pumps/plimsolls, stiletto heels, sandals, platform shoes or sling back shoes).

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WHERE STUDENTS ARRIVE AT SCHOOL WEARING UNIFORM THAT DOES NOT MEET CARDINAL WISEMAN CATHOLIC SCHOOL UNIFORM REGULATIONS, PARENTS WILL BE CONTACTED WITH AN EXPECTATION THAT THE UNIFORM IS CHANGED.

Students will often cite members of their peer group as wearing a style of non-regulation shoe as a rea-son for them to wear incorrect and sometimes unsafe footwear. However Cardinal Wiseman Catholic School will challenge all students in terms of footwear.

STUDENTS WILL BE ASKED TO CHANGE FOOTWEAR NOT CONSIDERED TO BE OF SCHOOL REGULATION IMMEDIATELY.

Please find a selection of trouser styles from which to choose from, which are acceptable school uniform. **NB** - **no** jeans or chinos.

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SHOES FOR BOYS

Black lace up or slip on shoes/ankle/shoe boots. (No logos, heavy boots, training shoes, canvas pumps/plimsolls or Velcro — see illustration).

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P.E. KIT

- Rugby jersey in Cardinal Wiseman colours.
- Rugby socks in Cardinal Wiseman colours.
- Navy polo shirt for PE with Cardinal Wiseman badge.
- Navy shorts with Cardinal Wiseman badge.
- Navy tracksuit bottoms with Cardinal Wiseman badge.
- Shin pads/gum shield/football boots for boys unless girls take part in extracurricular football.
- Multi-purpose/cross trainers.
- Swimming trunks or shorts (boys), one-piece swimsuit (girls).
- Towel.
