IMPACT

Accelerated reader	75% of year 7's reading ages improved. 40.5% of year 7's reading ages improved by more than 1 year.
Part of salary of librarian	Identified students read with, during accelerated reader sessions and reading skills evaluated to enable assessment of progress. Library resources reviewed to ensure appropriate range of reading materials available and identified students advised on the most suitable books and when to proceed to higher levels. Small groups taken out to complete assessments and enable right selection of books to be made.
Resources for library – chrome books (10)	Enabled students to complete the assessments anywhere in the school. Support for students after school to complete homework tasks Also increase used for homework and extracurricular activities These were also used to support key worker students during school closure, so work set on google classroom could be completed
Part of salary of KS3 Coordinator, English	Member of staff supported year 7 and coordinated the accelerated reader programme
Romero MAC year 6-7 numeracy and transition link	Small groups of students received 6 week interventions in either literacy or numeracy, all improved on their baseline assessments.
Book boxes for year 7 tutor groups	8 book boxes for year 7 tutor groups were put together, each box contained 30 copies of the same book, so the tutor group could all read the book together. Due to school closure tutor groups only started with one book, this will continue 2020/21
Resources for Trinity – chrome books (10) – to be used to support small group literacy intervention	Additional chrome books brought for literacy interventions, students were identified based on meetings with the SENCO and the literacy coordinator and also the head of year. Majority of students improved their reading age after specific school group intervention, those who did not, had additional assessment work.
